
ORDER CONCERNING ELECTRONIC DEVICES IN THE COURTROOM

It is the Order of the Fort Peck Tribal Court that, except with the express permission of the presiding judge, all electronic devices inside a courtroom shall remain off and no electronic device may be used to receive, transmit or record sound, visual images, data or other information.

Any individual who willfully violates this Order or any reasonable limitation imposed by the presiding judge may be found in contempt of court and may be subject to sanctions including a minimum fine of \$25.00.

This policy shall remain in effect until further notice or until superseded by future policy. Failure of an employee to adhere to this policy may result in disciplinary action which may include termination.
