## **CIVIL JUDGMENT**

Purpose: This form is used by the court to formally issue a judgment in a civil

action.

How: According to a judge's order, the clerk prepares the judgment for

signature. After the judge signs the judgment, the clerk transmits the

copies.

Copies: The original is stored in the court case file.

A copy is give to the plaintiff, defendant and their advocates.

Notes: The following sample judgment form should probably be used only

for relatively simple judgment/orders. A longer narrative-type judgment/order should be prepared for cases that are more complex.

The following sample form provides space for entry of satisfaction of

judgment, which must be signed by the person in whose favor

judgment was rendered and by the clerk of court when satisfaction of

judgment is recorded.
