DEFAULT JUDGMENT

- Purpose: This is the form used by the court to enter a judgment against a defendant who has defaulted, i.e., has not appeared in court or answered the plaintiff's complaint and summons.
- How: Upon failure of the defendant to respond to or answer the plaintiff's complaint within the time limitations established by law, the plaintiff may petition the court for a default judgment. If the defendant has been properly served with the complaint and summons, the court may issue a judgment against the defendant.
- Copies: The original is stored in the court case file A copy is given to the defendant and the plaintiff.
