

ORDER FOR PERMANENT CUSTODY

- Purpose: This is the form used by the court to grant permanent custody of a child(ren) to a parent or guardian.
- How: After the filing of a petition for custody and a hearing on the matter, the form is completed by the clerk of court at the direction of the judge and signed by the judge.
- Copies: The original order is stored in the court case file.
Copies of the order are given to all relevant parties, i.e., mother, father, guardian, etc.
