

PETITION FOR EXPUNGEMENT OF RECORD

Title VI, Chapter 9 provides for a person to petition the Court to take a charge off the public record of the Court and the public record of Law Enforcement. Only one charge can be petitioned for at a time.

The petitioner is required to state their full name, age and address. The petitioner must state the cause or case number of their case, the crime charged and the sentence imposed. The petitioner must state how they completed the sentence and the reason why they want the record expunged.

To make the process move efficiently, the petitioner should provide the Court with documents that show that the terms of their sentence were completed. These documents should be with the petition but could be presented at the hearing.

The petition will be served on the Chief Prosecutor who will verify the statements in the petition and make a recommendation to the Court within 10 days.

A hearing must be held and an order issued within 30 days of when the petition was filed.

The cost to file the petition is \$25.00. No waiver of fee is available for this petition
